VISITING THE LIBRARY

Our opening hours: The Library is open between 10am and 9pm Monday to Thursday, and 10am to 6pm Friday to Sunday. Please note that our galleries and display spaces generally close at 5pm each day.

Our location: The library is located at **328 Swanston Street, Melbourne**, on the corner of La Trobe Street.

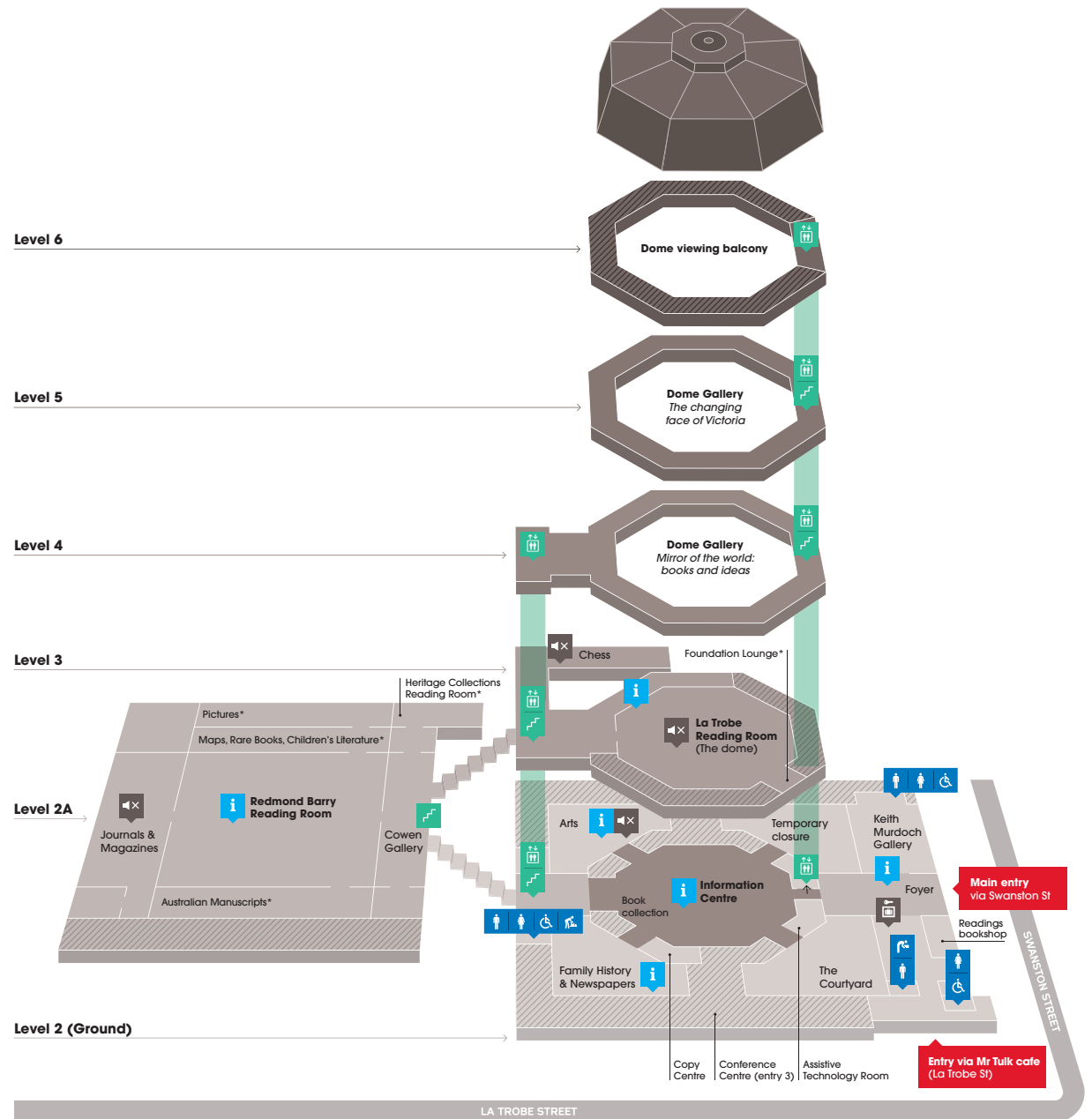
By car: The library does not have on-site parking, but there are several convenient public car parks, including paid car parks at Melbourne Central and QV.

By public transport: Trams pass the library's entrances on Swanston and La Trobe streets, and the nearest bus stops are Lonsdale, Russell and Exhibition streets. Melbourne Central Train Station is directly opposite the Library's entrance.

By bike: There are dedicated bike lanes in both directions on Swanston Street and east on La Trobe Street. There are bike racks on the corner of Swanston and La Trobe streets, and on the corner of Swanston and Little Lonsdale streets.

AT THE LIBRARY

If you need a break, Mr Tulk, our cafe/restaurant, is located within our boundaries on our Swanston and La Trobe street corner, and our Readings bookstore is located in Palmer Hall to the left off the Library foyer.
