State Library Victoria is currently seeking expressions of interest from artists who are current or former international students to develop new video works for presentation in the Central Information Centre on the video screens.

This call out is open to all international students who are artists – either established or emerging. Artists from all backgrounds and working in **video and screen-based arts** are encouraged to apply. Proposals are encouraged to respond to broad themes of the city and built environment or your experiences as a student in the Library. Artworks in **animation**, **game art** or **illustration** will be preferenced.

State Library Victoria will assist the successful artists in adapting their work for the screens, but work must be made with the technical specs in mind (see below).

The commissions will be presented as part of State Library Victoria's **Student Takeover on Friday 17 March 2023.** Come to the Library for a Cypher Culture dance battle, meet local students in a friendship speed-dating, food tasting, multi-lingual tours and make new friends.

Technical Specifications

All final artwork must be delivered according to the specifications and format of our Information Centre screens:

- PNG or MP4
- Duration: Minimum 30 seconds, Maximum 3 minutes
- Please note the screens are presented in a arid but to be used as a whole. Screen design image.
- There is no audio available
- The dimensions are 7680px w x 2160px h
- All content needs to be family friendly and aimed at all ages

 SLV makes the final call on all content, regardless of selection

Selection Requirements

Applicants must be a current or former international student at any stage of study (undergraduate or postgraduate), within the last 3 years. Applicants will be asked to confirm this as part of the application process.

Application is open to single, pairs or collectives of artists – but the fee remains the same as outlined below.

- Successful applicants will be chosen by SLV staff and current/ former international students.
- State Library makes the final call on all content and suitability and reserves the right to refuse screening if the work is deemed unsuitable for our audiences.
- Selection will consider diversity of age, gender, ability, cultural and disciplinary background and prioritise access and inclusion.

Payment

- Each successful submission will receive a payment of \$800. This will be paid in two amounts \$400 for development and \$400 on completion.
- Artists will be asked to sign a State Library Victoria Supplier Engagement Agreement

- A short biography and/or CV
- Up to 3 images of existing works of art that are

indicative of the kind of work you make, and that relate to the work of art you would like to develop for the digital screens;

- A brief project proposal (up to 200 words). What do you propose to develop for the digital screens?
- Please include IST artist commission in subject line of your email
