# MAKE A FISH

**YOU WILL NEED**

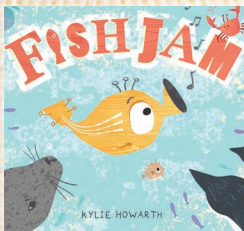
- Paper circle or paper plate
- Paper for making the tail and fins
- Collage materials
- Glue/tape

**STEPS:**

- 1 Take a paper plate and cut out a triangle mouth shape on one side. If you don't have a paper plate, cut out a paper/card circle - draw around a plate to get a perfect circle shape. This is your fish's body.
- 2 Cut out a paper triangle and glue it to the side of the fish's body opposite the mouth to make a tail. If you used a paper plate to make the body, you can use the cut-out piece from the mouth for the tail.
- 3 Cut out two smaller triangles and glue them to the side of the fish's body to be fins.
- 4 Decorate your fish by using collage materials to create an eye and scales.

*Does your fish live in cold water or warm tropical water?*

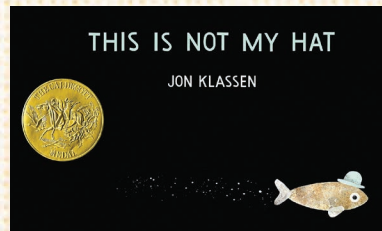

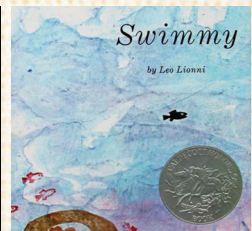
