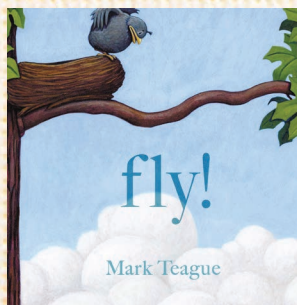
FLY OR FALL?

YOU WILL NEED

-  Various objects
-  A large piece of paper or cardboard to mark out a landing mat

STEPS:

-  Place your landing mat on the floor in a clear space.
-  Look at various objects with a grown-up guess whether they will fly or fall heavily onto the mat. You could look at objects such as feathers, paper planes, rocks or toys.
-  Test your hypotheses by dropping various objects onto the landing mat.
-  Discuss why some objects fly and some fall heavily. Think about things like surface area, weight and shape.
