# WHALE

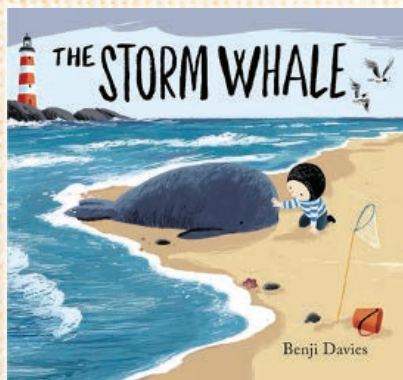
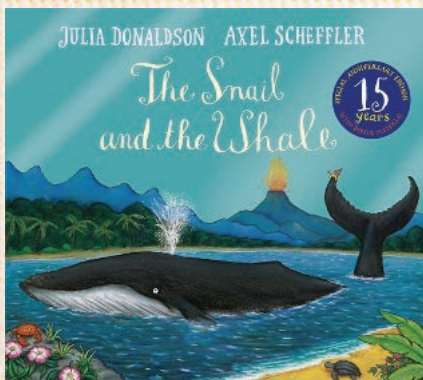
### YOU WILL NEED

- Paper cup or clean tin
- 2 A4 pieces of paper
- Paper strips
- Coloured felt-tip markers, crayons or pencils
- Tape
- Scissors

### STEPS:

- 1 Colour in one piece of paper, and wrap and tape it around the paper cup to make the body of a whale.
- 2 Cut out a pair of circles from the second piece of paper to create eyes, and colour them in.
- 3 Cut out a whale tail from the second piece of paper and decorate it.
- 4 Tape the eyes to the whale shape.
- 5 Tape the tail to the bottom of the whale shape.
- 6 Tape some paper strips to the top of your whale's head.
